He also urged to listen directly from the beneficiaries and their parents

from next term in such programmes. More importantly, he asked every beneficiaries and

their parents to ensure the spending of money for the desired purpose and to keep track of the accounting under this head. The school principal was requested by I/c General Manager (P) to verify at least 10% account randomly to have a better monitoring process.

The programme ended with vote of thanks and light refreshment. This scheme has not only played an important role of creating bondage between the local villagers and GMDC but certainly showed many poor girls the path of brighter future by way of continuing education in building the society and the nation as well.
